Dear Parent / Carer,

Please can you ensure that you do not arrive at the school before your exit time to support us in reducing the 'bottle neck' at the top gate.

Please can I also ask that we continue to limit the number of adults on site and therefore only one adult per family to drop off and collect.

We also strongly advise that families walk or cycle to school to avoid the build up of cars and movement of people on the roads surrounding school.

#### **Back Packs**

### **Baseline assessments**

As a school we will be assessing the children over the next few weeks to establish a clear baseline and also to identify gaps in learning. Your child's teacher will be using this information to tailor their curriculum offer to ensure that no child is left behind. As well as the school core offer we will be offering additional intervention work which may take place during the school day or after school. Details of the interventions will be shared by individual year groups in the next couple of weeks.
