The Coronavirus pandemic presents unprecedented challenges for all sectors, including education, and keeping children safe whilst accessing school or associated services must be our top priority.

The school does not underestimate the value of accessible wrap around care for families and we try to take a balanced view when considering standards of infection prevention and control in relation to COVID-19. We must however hold ourselves and partners accountable to the highest achievable standards. In addition to these challenges, there remains uncertainty at a national level about the response to Coronavirus which presents challenges when planning service delivery. The school is working hard to remain agile amongst this uncertainty and provide the best environment and experiences possible for our children.

Whilst it is unfortunate that Acorns have decided not to reopen, the school will now take stock and closely monitor all opportunities as they arise over the coming months.
