

blustery adj. windy or gusty; like gusts of wind that turn your umbrella inside out

word pairs: conditions, wind, afternoon


The weather began to turn and before long it was blustery outside.

whirlwind n. like a hurricane or tornado; like wind that spins and sweeps everything up

word pairs: violent, sudden, destructive




All of a sudden, a whirlwind scattered the leaves in every direction.



gust n. a blast of air or strong breeze; like a puff of wind so strong it blows things away word pairs: sudden, strong, violent

A gust of wind caught the plastic bag and lifted it high into the air.

persevere v. to keep going or carry on; like running all the way to the end of a marathon word pairs: steadily, somehow, resolutely



Although many people doubted his idea, the inventor persevered with his dream.



people who have promised to stay together word pairs: couple, relationship, performance

His committed attitude led to amazing scientific developments.

determined adj. driven or completely set on; like working extra hard to get what you want word pairs: effort, expression, opponent



The scientist was determined to change the world with her discoveries.
