



crevasse *n.* a crack or chasm; like a deep hole that you could never climb out of
word pairs: deep, hidden, narrow



precipitous *adj.* steep or dangerously high; like the edge of a very scary mountain
word pairs: cliff, slope, descent

steep *adj.* sharp and vertical; like the big, snowy drop beneath a cable car
word pairs: drop, path, stairs

summit *n.* top or peak; the very highest point of a mountain where you can plant your flag
word pairs: climb, approach, attempt
