

Features of a newspaper report

- Headline (a short title that often uses alliteration or puns e.g. Famous Franklin or The Key to Electricity)
- Sub-headline to tell the reader a little more. Think of it as a blurb for a newspaper report.
- Third person
- Formal tone
- Direct speech in the form of quotes from witnesses or bystanders
- Past tense
- 5 Ws (where, when, who, what, why)
- Pictures with captions
