



All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a 'free' school lunch funded by the government. This is different to Free School Meals and you must apply for FSM to receive the PP benefits listed.

In order to claim FSMs a parent/carer must be claiming one of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
- Child Tax Credit Only (with income up to £16,190) with no element of Working Tax Credit
- National Asylum Seekers Support
- Guarantee Element of the State Pension Credit
- Employment and Support Allowance (income related)
- Universal Credit (income dependant)



What are you entitled to?

- One school jumper or cardigan and PE t-shirt a year
- Half price educational trips or internal visits throughout the year.
- A £100 contribution towards the cost of the Year 6 residential.
- One after school PE club provided by Pacesetters a year.
- 50% of the cost for music lessons for one instrument provided by Northamptonshire Music and Performing Arts Trust a year .
- Free School milk

- A contribution towards a range of clubs for children to attend.
