English task:

Please complete the following activities:

- 1. Listen or read Chapter 3 of King of the Cloud Forests. Look at the powerpoint and read the example on Slide 2. Using the features shown on Slide 3, highlight the features shown in the text. Can you explain WHY that feature is needed?
