<u>Maths</u>

Roll a dice then draw that number of spots on a ladybird. https://www.twinkl.co.uk/resource/t-n-672-double-theladybird-spots-sheets

Simple ladybird doubles: Introduce the concept of doubling as adding the same number together. If you have 1 spot on each wing, how many spots altogether? 1+1=2 or double 1 is 2. Repeat for 2,3,4,5 etc. Draw the spots or you could use objects to help.
