- 2. What did Bullseye do when Oliver went near the door? snarled showing his sharp fangs
- 3. Find another word for 'waved' in the text. brandished
- 4. How did Bill describe the house Oliver was going to that night?

 Big house, loaded with silver and jewels
- 5. How do you think Oliver felt when Bill dragged Oliver to the house? Why? Use evidence from the text to support your answer.
 - Mention of a feeling such as worried / scared / frightened with evidence from the text to support their answer. E.g. I think Oliver may have felt scared as in the text it says 'Sikes raised his fist. "Do it, or I'll bash your head in."'
- 6. What did Bill hand to Oliver once he was in the house?

 Lantern
- 7. How do you think Oliver felt before he dropped the lantern? Why? Use evidence from the text to support your answer.
 - Mention of a feeling such as brave / worried / nervous with evidence from the text to support their answer. E.g. I think Oliver may have felt brave as in the text it says "I don't care what happens to me" and he dropped the lantern with a clatter.'
- 8. What did Bill do to Oliver when they left the house? he flung him into a ditch
- 9. What did Nancy do when she found Oliver? bandaged his bleeding arm with her shawl
- 10. Where did Nancy take Oliver?

- 11. How does the book describe the dog following Nancy and Oliver? a dog with a scratched torn face and an eager snarling mouth.
- 12. How did Bill try to escape?

 He climbed the drainpipe of a nearby house and scaled the roof.
- 13. How do you think Oliver felt when Mr Brownlow held him in his arms? Why? Use evidence from the text to support your answer.
 - Mention of a feeling such as safe / scared with evidence from the text to support their answer. E.g. I think Oliver may have felt safe as in the text it says "I'm here, Oliver" said Mr Brownlow reassuringly.'
- 14. What did Mr Brownlow hand Oliver?

 A gold locket
