Key Vocabulary

Mechanism - components acting together to make an action take place.

Slider - a rigid bar which moves backwards and forwards along a straight line. Unlike a lever, a slider does not have a pivot point.


Lever - a rigid bar which moves around a pivot. Levers are used in many everyday products. In this project children will use card strips for levers and paper fasteners for pivots.

Pivot - a point about which a lever turns

Use the information you collected yesterday to draw a map of your walk. The Map will be your

background for your slider.

Once your map is finished, draw a picture of yourself - this will be your slider to travel around your map.

Once your character is finished - glue or tape the slider to the back of it. Use the same technique that worked when you made your slider on Monday ©





Card or lolly stick will work!

Cut a line along the road or your path (remember not to cut the paper in half!)



Push your slider through and take your character on a walk around your map.
