



ambush v. to make a surprise attack; like a soldier leaping out suddenly from a hiding place
word pairs: enemy, prey, troops

conquer v. to defeat or get control over; like an army taking over new land
word pairs: country, world, fears



bicker v. to argue over silly things; like sisters arguing about nothing
word pairs: constantly, playfully, childish

feud n. a conflict that is never settled; like people fighting about the same thing for years
word pairs: bitter, long-running, vicious



bombard v. to attack or overwhelm; like showering someone with gifts on their birthday
word pairs: enemy, town, castle

siege n. a blockade or assault; when soldiers surround the enemy until they surrender
word pairs: brutal, long, bloody



fight or battle words

word pair before:

bitter **feud**
brutal **siege**

word pair after:

ambush the enemy
bicker constantly
bombard the enemy
conquer a country
