We all mostly have the same kind of body parts in the same place.









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Simon Says...

Play Simon says with your child, can they point to the correct part of the body?

Rules:

One player is Simon and the players follow Simons instructions. They players must obey all commands that begin with 'Simon Says'. E.g if Simon says "Simon says touch your ears" then all players must touch their ears.

However, if Simon says "touch your shoulders" without saying "Simon Says" the players must not follow this command. If they players do they are out until the next game.
