

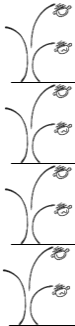

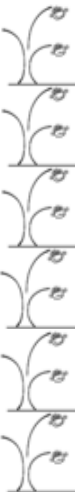
Use these boxes on the side to write down words you want to include in each paragraph when you write it. Use the example to magpie words. Think of interesting sentence openers and conjunctions you can include.

Make bullet points for: When and where she was born. Who she lived with. What she did to help her mother on the farm.

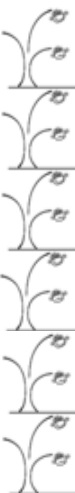
