

## English

In the first half term, we will be writing two narratives: one as a re-telling of a traditional tale and another based on a text. In the second half term, we will write a newspaper report about our exciting trip to New Walk museum.

## Maths

In Maths this term, we will cover the following units:

- Place value
- Addition and subtraction
- Introduction to multiplication and division

Expect plenty of practical work, building into pictorial representations and written methods.

## Science/STEM

**Science:** We will begin the term with a focus on rocks, soil and fossils before covering a short unit on Earth and space.

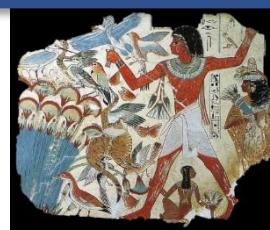
**D&T:** We will be developing our sewing skills as we create our own hanging fabric Christmas tree decorations.
