Title: 'Musicals'



Communication Language and Literacy

This term, we will be focussing on a range of different musicals in preparation for our end of year production 'Grease'. Year 6 will be working hard to ensure we have lots of evidence towards the end of year writing expectations during the start of the Summer 2 term. We will be revising and accurately using various spelling, punctuation and grammatical structures within our writing which will include: using semi-colons and colons; commas for list and within sentences; a range of adverbials and conjunctions; accurately punctuated dialogue as well as ensuring our handwriting is beautifully presented.

We will be using our knowledge of musicals' to help us with our drama, speaking and listening skills as we prepare our end of year 6 production.

Physical Development and PSED

Our PE day is Friday. We expect full PE kit to be in school as PE is part of the national curriculum. Please ensure all children have plimsolls for indoor PE and trainers for outdoors PE.

We may also be doing some extra PE on days so please ensure your child has their PE kit in school all week.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

Our learning journey this term is 'Musicals' This learning journey will enable the children to revise their knowledge and understanding of a range of times within history where many different musicals are set and during different time periods. This will include revising their knowledge of America where a number of famous and popular musicals are set, particularly 'Grease'.

The children will be heavily involved in creating props, staging, leaflets, advertising and artwork for our end of year production - *Grease*.

Mathematical Development

There will also be an opportunity for some of our year 6 children to become mathematical mentors for some of our year 5 pupils who are just starting to think about polishing up their maths skills ready for year 6.
